



Director of Young Faith Formation

Closes May 21st, 2023

Purpose: To collaborate with the Pastor and Christian Education Committee to develop and implement educational experiences for Children's Sunday School and Youth Group. The candidate will lead the Children's Sunday School Program, and Co-Direct the Youth Group with the Pastor.

Supervisor: Pastor and Christian Education Committee

Time Requirements: Worship begins at 10:15am, with the candidate's arrival time being no later than 10am. Children's Sunday School meets weekly during worship after the "Faith Explorers" Children's Moment. Sunday School lasts between 30-45 minutes. Youth Group meets twice a month after church from 11:30am-1:30pm.

The candidate will be expected to attend Youth Group service or fellowship outings, which should take place no less than once per quarter.

Additional Christian Education Committee meetings will be scheduled once per quarter, typically on a Sunday, with your attendance.

Responsibilities:

- Review and develop curriculum with Pastor.
- Ensure proper supplies are stocked and ordered.
- Pursue and schedule Youth volunteer and fellowship outings.
- Recruit volunteers.
- Work with the Pastor with teaching/leading Confirmation classes.
- Determine financial needs of Young Faith Formation and develop an annual budget.

- Provide up to date schedules to Office Assistant for Bulletins and Newsletters.
- Participate in annual the Vacation Bible School program.
- Attend all Sunday School, Youth Group gatherings and Christian Education Meetings with four Sunday's off per year.
- Abide by IUCC Safe Church Policy.

Qualifications: Working knowledge of United Church of Christ, or other progressive Christian ministries. We are a safe and inclusive church and expect our staff to cultivate an equally safe and inclusive environment. Please see our Open and Affirming Statement for a deeper understanding of who we are. We aren't looking for the most qualified or experienced person. We are looking for the right person who will lead the young people of Immanuel UCC with love and care.

Pay and Time Off: \$10,000 annually with four Sunday's off per calendar year.
